In 2007, the Council of State of the region of Vaud, organised an architectural competition for a new parliament building as the old one, situated in the historic medieval centre of the city of Lausanne, burnt down in 2002. In 2009 of the 33 projects chosen in the first phase and then the five finalists, the competitions international jury chaired by Norman Foster awarded the prize to the project design by a Barcelona architect practice of Bonell I Gil Arquitectes, and Atelier Cube of Lausanne.
