Born in the late 14th century (1364-1430) Christine De Pizan served as a court writer for several dukes as well as for the French royal court during the reign of Charles VI. Supported and encouraged by important royal French and English patrons, she influenced 15th-century English poetry. She is the first woman known to make a living by writing. She wrote love ballads, books supporting and extolling the powers and virtues of women, and a work about Joan of Arc.
