The Museum Rath is offering an approach to them through the magnificent 17<sup>th</sup> century tapestries from the Toms Pauli Foundation in Lausanne and from the Museum of Art and History's own collection, most of which have been in storage for over fifty years and have undergone conservation treatment specially for the occasion.

Set against objects from Antiquity – status, intaglios, prints, books, coins, etc. – these tapestries enable us to appreciate today the interest taken in these great figures in the era of Louis XIV and to understand the message they convey.
